- I will rejoice with other's happiness and when any member is undergoing difficulties, will care for and support them, bearing their burdens, and earnestly praying on their behalf.
- I will strive to faithfully and regularly share the gospel with others as the Lord gives me occasion to proclaim the good news of His salvation.

Below is a further, expanded explanation of our covenant with Scripture references:

- I will faithfully engage in the life of the church by submitting to the preaching of the word and the ordinances in the weekly worship gathering, I will participate in discipleship, and pursue community with a willing obedience to the Lord. - I will pursue an affectionate, sincere, genuine love in all things towards my brothers and sisters as Christ has for His church (John 15:12, John 13:34,35, Rom. 13:8)
